#### Tasting Notes

The over-ripe, partially desiccated fruit with a hint of botrytis yields a tropical paradise in your glass. A complex, aromatic nose with dried rose petals, orange blossom, poached peaches, pear and caramel apple with an exotic note of Earl Grey tea. Sweet, lush and rich with crisp balancing acidity, dried apricot, dried flowers and honey lead to fresh grapefruit and lime with chalky minerality on the long finish.
